## Number of Burlington PD Heroin Sales & Possession Violations

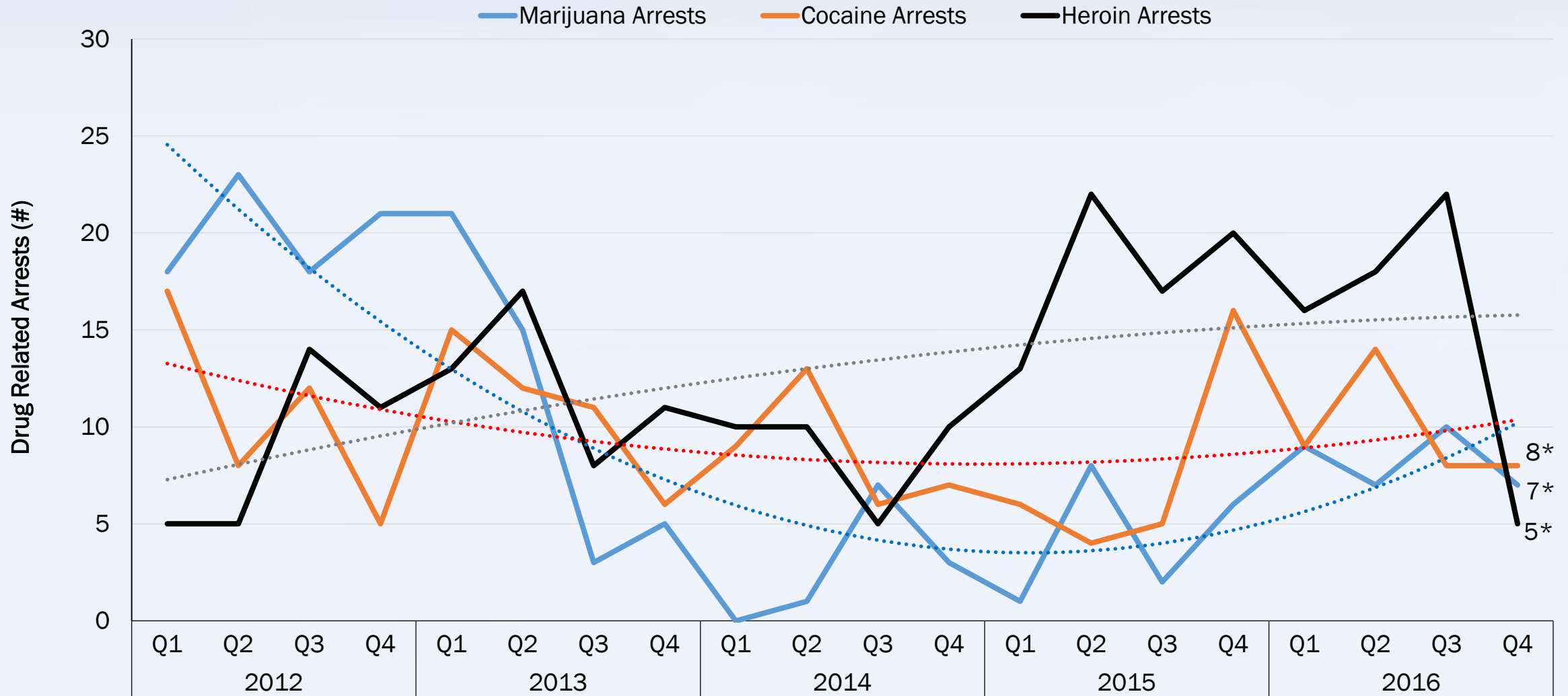

## Number of Burlington PD Drug Arrests by Drug Type

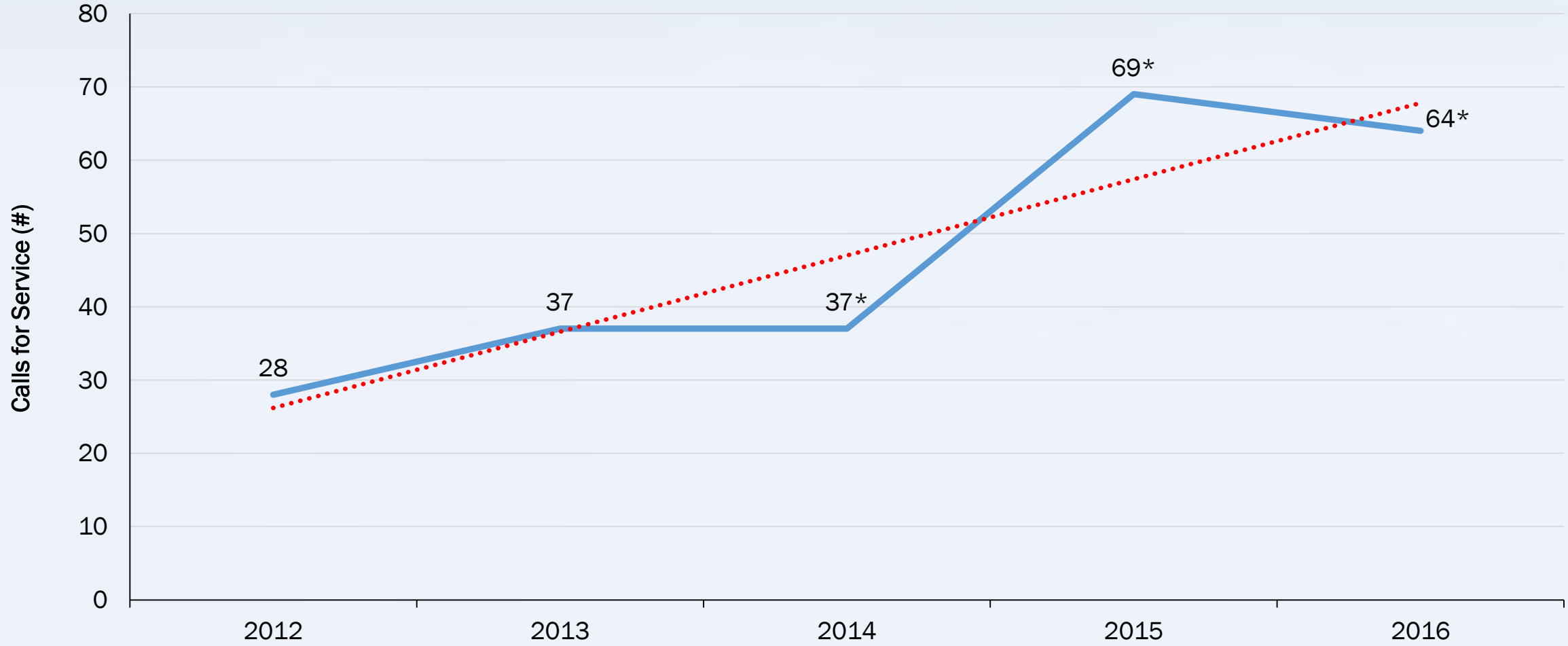

## Number of Burlington PD Calls for Service Classified as "Overdose"\*

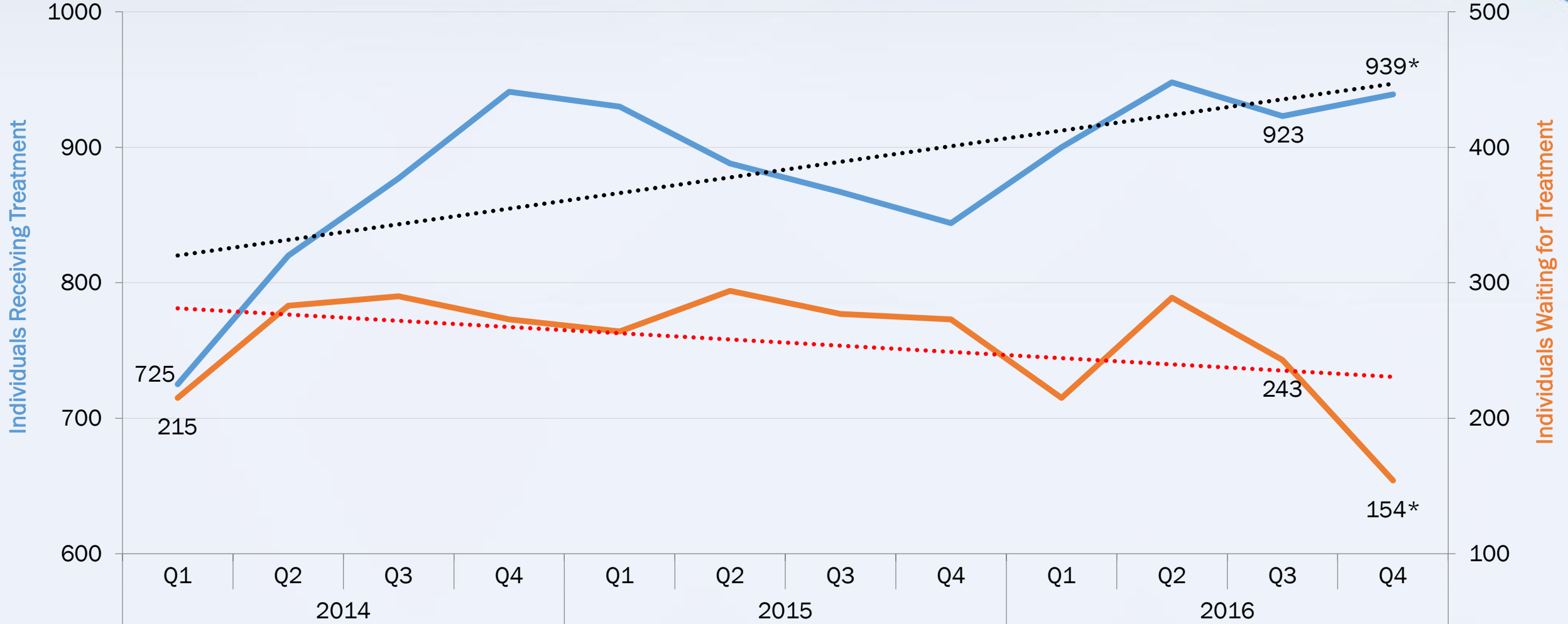

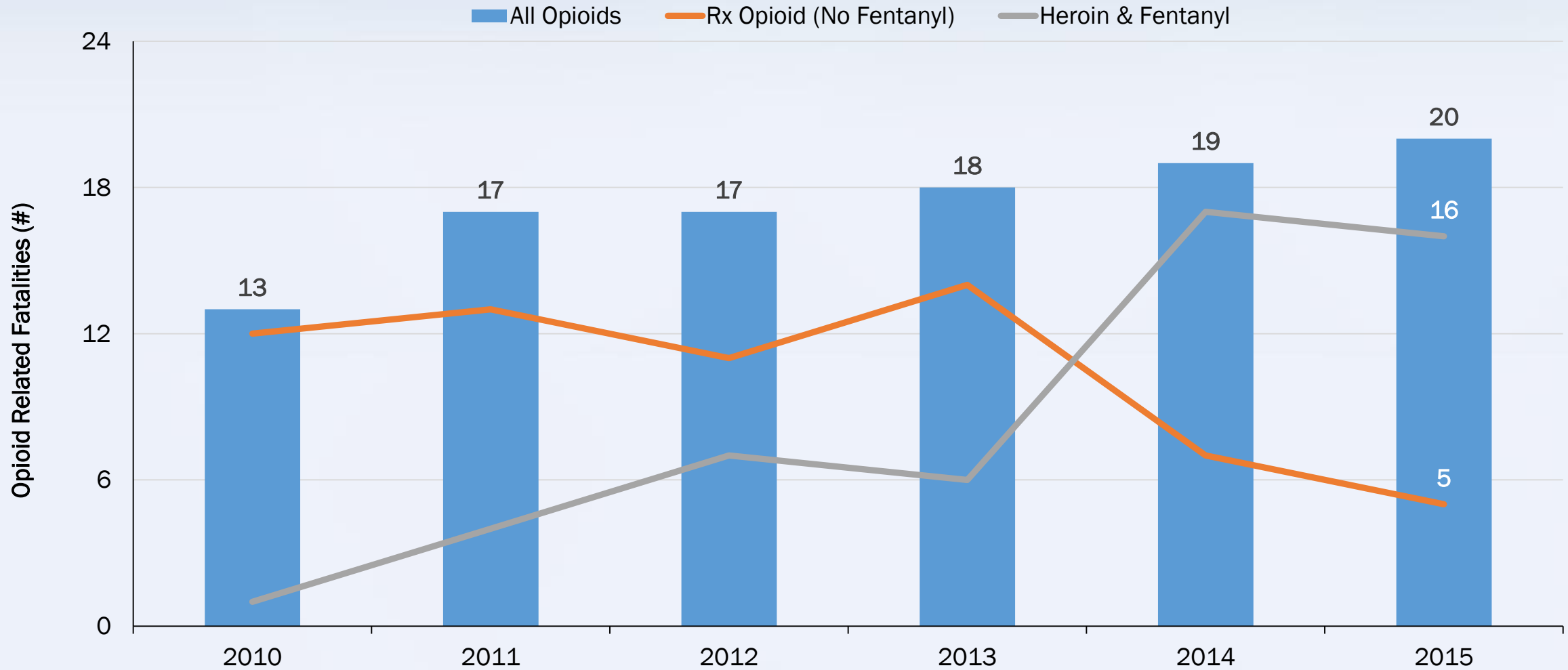

- BHA Data liaison identified and in contact with CommStat about data collection efforts



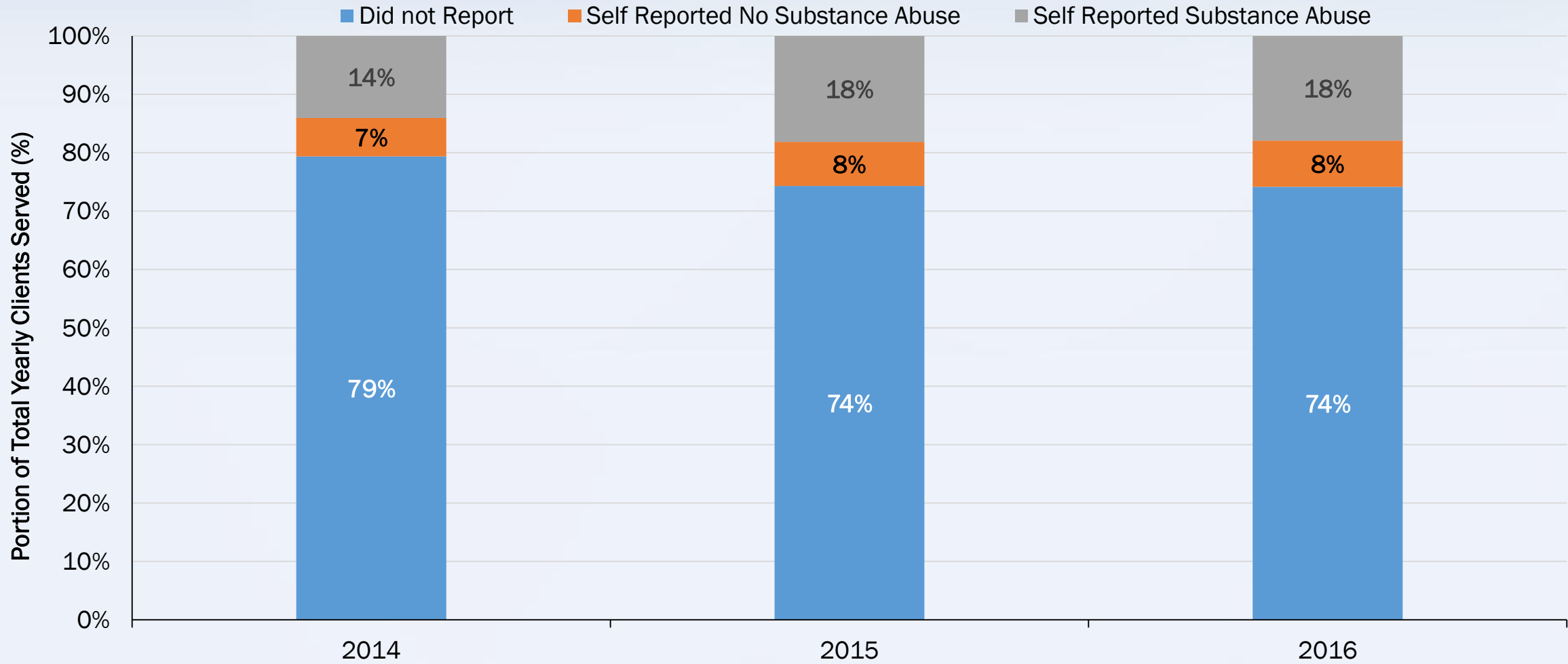

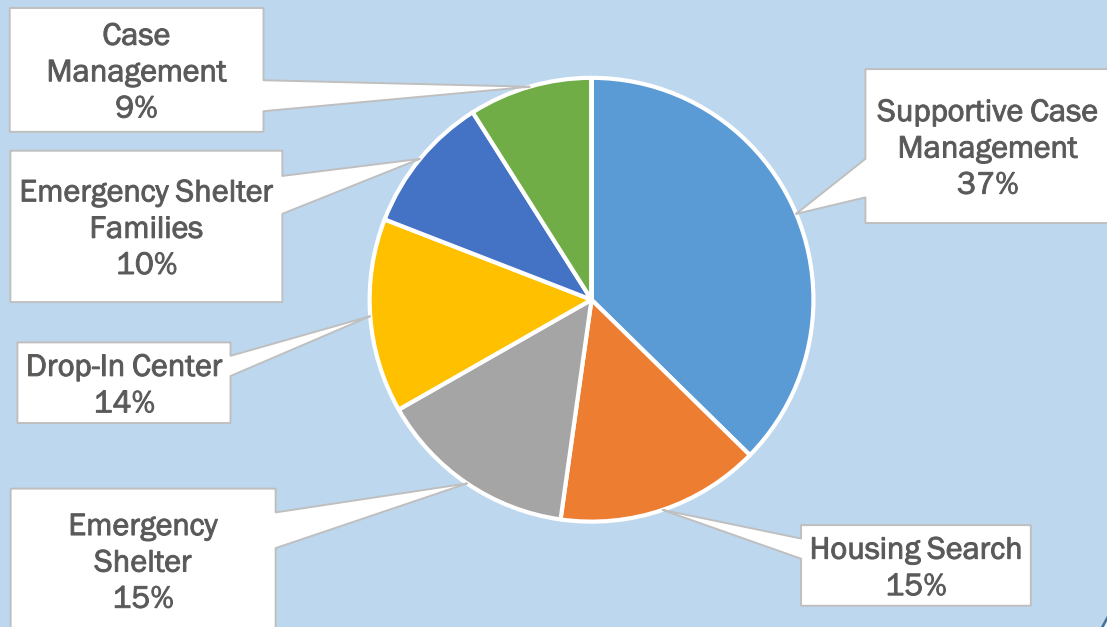

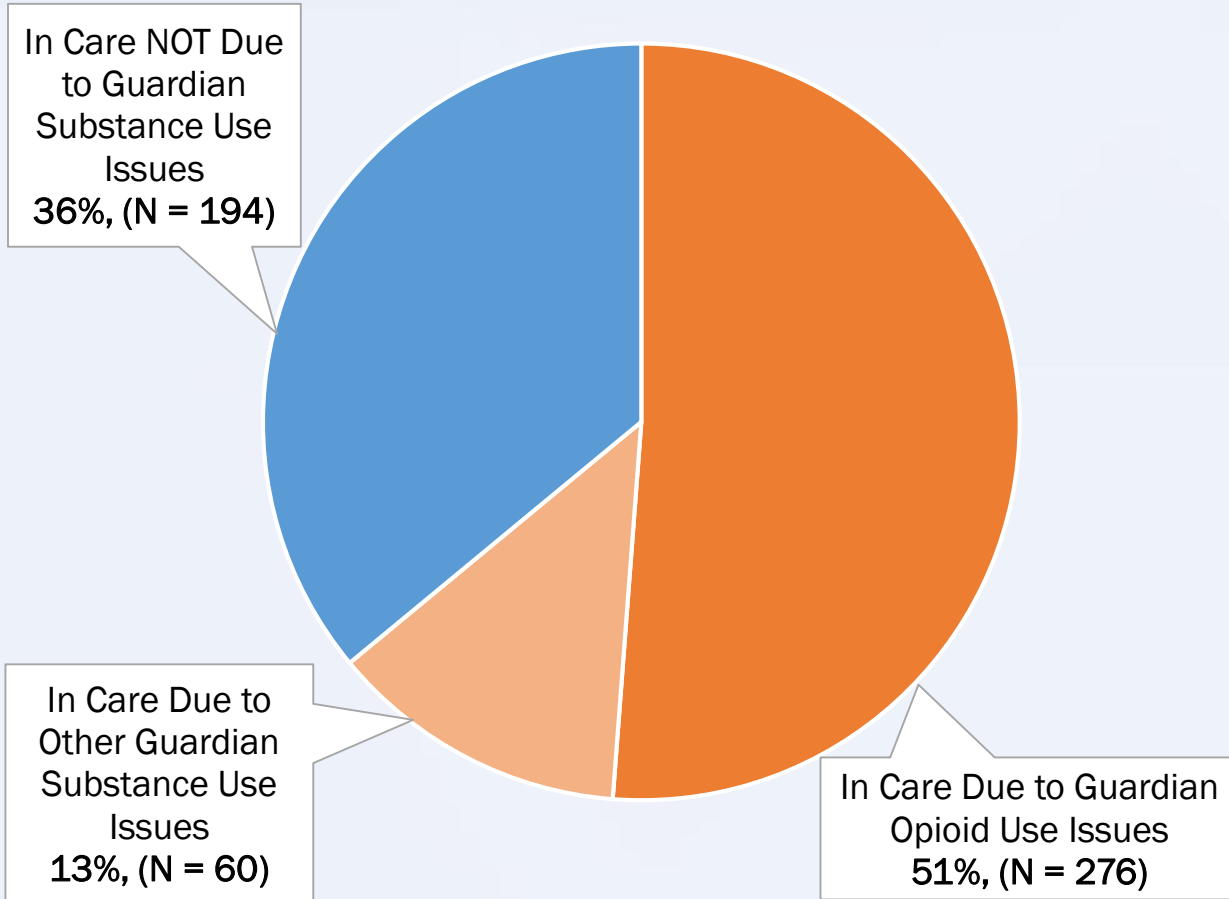

- DCF provided preliminary data from 2015 and have indicated they are willing to do further analysis alongside CommStat team

The majority of cases with children under 6 involve **guardian opioid abuse** or related issues.

15.94% of the total youth under six who came into custody due to a guardian’s opioid abuse did so in Chittenden County (44 of 276 cases)
