## Burlington Police Department Heroin Violations, 2012 - 2016




### Number of Burlington PD Heroin Sales & Possession Violations



## Number of Burlington PD Calls for Service Classified as "Overdose"\*









## Committee on Temporary Shelter Burlington Client Substance Abuse, 2014 - 2016




### Rate of Self-Reported Substance Abuse Among COTS Burlington Clients, by Response Type


