Discuss draft backbone position description, answer questions (page 12)	In discussing the draft project director position description, all agreed to add project management certification (or the ability to demonstrate this skill) as a preferred skill. In discussing the draft data analyst position prepared by the City/BPD, many members raised questions about data ownership and reporting structure. This discussion reinforced the need to clarify data governance plans and the day-to-day vision for each position.
